Grace: Not a direct link, but I received care at different places, its not the same staff- no continuity, saw a different midwife at each appointment. I was a high risk pregnancy, previous losses – said it on the first page on the notes. The deeper issue was that my notes were not really looked at. That vital info on front being missed. Having to repeat. Distressing!

Leona: They do use stickers with the paper green notes, but don't know how it is flagged on badgernet? They are doing more work to better the App, constantly updating it and standardising the approach and use of it.

Grace: They need to ensure target high risk/baby loss service users don't have further or unnecessary distress caused.
